## VACCINE COVERAGE

Cigna provides coverage for many Part B vaccines and Part D vaccines. There is one cost for the vaccine and another cost for administration. The total amount a patient will pay depends on the type of vaccine, where it's administered, and who administers it.

### Part B vaccines

Vaccines that are administered through Part B medical coverage, as documented on the reverse side of this flyer, generate a 20% coinsurance for the member after they are administered.

Provider offices will submit appropriate CPT code for vaccine administration to the health plan. The administration of a Part B vaccine will be billed to medical benefit – similar to other office-administered drugs.

### Part D vaccines

Three ways patients can get a Part D vaccines\*

Pharmacy only	Pharmacy and physician office	Physician office only
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Patient takes prescription for vaccine to retail pharmacy to be filled.</li> <li>▶ Pharmacist administers vaccine.</li> <li>▶ Pharmacy submits transaction for the vaccine – similar to other Part D prescriptions. Patient pays Part D copay/coinsurance.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Patient takes prescription for vaccine to retail pharmacy to be filled.</li> <li>▶ Pharmacy submits transaction for the vaccine – similar to other Part D prescriptions. Patient pays Part D copay/coinsurance.</li> <li>▶ Patient takes vaccine to physician's office to be administered. Physician administers vaccine.</li> <li>▶ Office may submit appropriate CPT code for vaccine administration to health plan. The administration of vaccine will be billed to the medical benefit – similar to other office administered drugs.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Patient goes to physician. Physician administers vaccine from office supply.</li> <li>▶ Patient pays out-of-pocket cost for vaccine and administration costs to office.</li> <li>▶ Patient submits reimbursement request, including receipt, to health plan.** Patient will be reimbursed based on contracted vaccine cost plus administration cost, minus copay/coinsurance.</li> </ul>

### Reminders

- ▶ Cigna covers most Part D eligible vaccines on Tier 3. Deductibles may apply.

\* Patients are responsible for all of the costs associated with vaccines (including the administration) during the deductible and coverage gap stages. Applies to Part D vaccines.
